
PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

- Identify hazard sources and obtain tsunami inundation maps and tsunami evacuation maps for vulnerable locations on Guam.
- Increase preparedness and response capabilities of all Government of Guam agencies, non Governmental Organizations, federal partners, and other key player whose services may directly affect adequate response to a tsunami event.
- Improve tsunami notification infrastructure
- Promote tsunami awareness through outreach and education
- Increase tsunami evacuation route signage throughout the island



Program Accomplishments

- TsunamiReady recognition 2006; renewed in 2012
- Robust mass multi-media awareness campaign
- "What's a Tsunami?" localized coloring book and posters for children in grades K-5
- Tsunami brochures in six languages
