 - Overall: The Palm Springs meeting really helped the Mitigation and Recovery Planning Work Group reset realistic goals and tasks for our annual work plan over the next year.
 We are now developing a new meeting schedule to focus on all this work.

- Maritime Tsunami Mitigation and Recovery -Although work was considered complete, we are exploring several mitigation/recovery items. Having said that, we have some projects we're able to leverage. One project is where:
 - CA initiating work on developing examples of post-2011 improvements to harbors which performed well during 2022 tsunami. The focus will be on Crescent City, Santa Cruz, and Moss Landing harbors. This will help feed into a benefit-cost analysis for our maritime guidance and possibly a future Hazus model. Our first step is to run numerical models of the Tonga event in these harbors.
