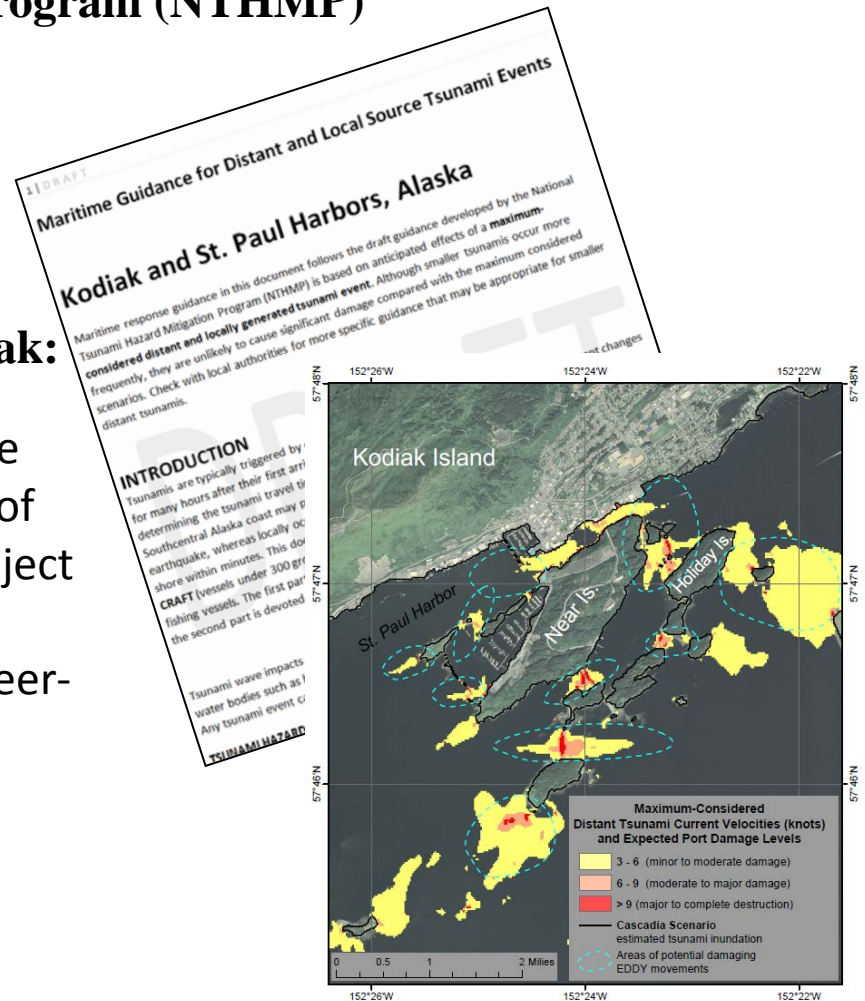


National Tsunami Hazard Mitigation Program (NTHMP)

Maritime Guidance document for Kodiak:

UAF developed an *initial* update to the tsunami hazard assessment for the City of Kodiak and USCG. This is an ongoing project and the first draft of the report is due in September. Then the draft will go to a peer-review and probably corrections to the inundation map.



Tsunami Program Activities



- Preliminary tsunami hazard maps for Adak, Akhiok, Atka, Chiniak, False Pass, Karluk, Larsen Bay, Old Harbor, Ouzinkie, Perryville, Port Lions, and Shemya were completed.

Mitigation and Education:

- Pedestrian evacuation travel time maps "from the tsunami hazard to safety" were presented to Chignik Bay, Homer, King Cove and Unalaska.
- Evacuation brochures are now online for local communities. Many have also begun developing their own or updating.
- NETAP Rover/Post Disaster Assessment course delivered to 35 persons in Valdez Alaska
- The National Disaster Preparedness Center's AWR-217 Tsunami Awareness course is requested to be delivered in Kodiak

TsunamiReady:

- Kodiak was re-recognized as TsunamiReady
- Kodiak is looking to update and support outlying villages
- Tsunami siren warning system being installed in Cordova

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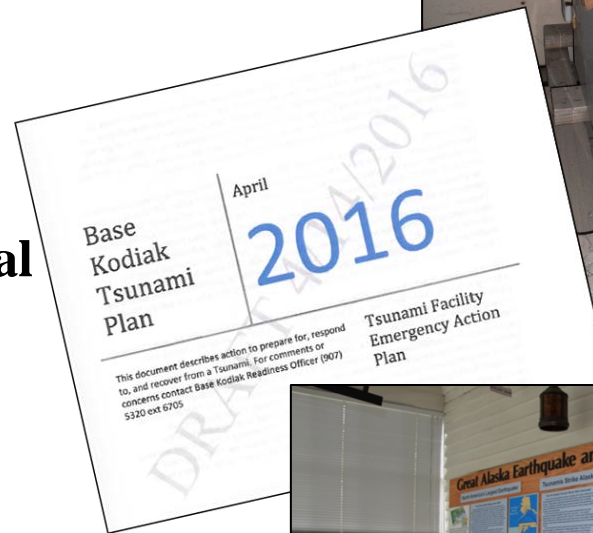
